Description

A joint endeavor was began in 2004 to protect at risk Aquatic Species in the Upper Nolichucky River. This is a partnership between NCFWS, NRCS and the Blue Ridge RC&D. The aim includes aiding in the recovery of declining populations of aquatic and endangered species, and restoring riparian stream habitats in the Nolichucky River.

 1. Apply for and/or administer at least two grant proposals from local sponsors by 2010.
 2. Assist the local sponsors in advertising the availability of funds for cost-sharing practices in two watersheds by 2012.
